School Uniform Policy

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY ESTCOTS PRIMARY SCHOOL



Children at Estcots must wear the correct school uniform. We aim for the children to take pride in being part of our school community and are therefore proud to wear it. It also ensures that the children's excellent behaviour never goes un-noticed when represent the school on trips, excursions and sporting events.

The uniform at Estcots consists of the following:

Boys

- **Grey** trousers or knee length grey shorts
- White shirt or polo shirts
- Green school logo sweatshirts
- Grey socks
- Black school shoes – NOT trainers or boots

Girls

- **Grey** pinafore, skirt, trousers or knee length shorts – NOT short fashion shorts
- White blouse or polo shirt
- Green school logo cardigan or sweatshirt
- Green and white striped/checked summer dress in the summer term
- White socks or grey tights
- Sensible flat heeled black school shoes - NOT trainers, boots, fashion shoes or open toe sandals

PE Kit

- Bottle green shorts
- PE t-shirt with school logo
- KS1 – black plimsolls
- KS2 – trainers

- Bottle green or grey track suit bottoms - optional

Accessories

- Bottle green book bag with the school logo
- Green PE bag with the school logo
- Green rucksack with the school logo – this is optional but other bags must not be larger than the school rucksack
- Baseball cap - optional
- Fleece with the school logo - optional
- Showerproof jacket with the school logo - optional

Jewellery

Children are allowed one small stud in each ear lobe and a watch. No other jewellery is permitted in school.

When the children are taking part in PE or school sporting events they are expected to take their earrings out. If the ears are newly pierced tape must be provided for the children to apply to their ears themselves.

Hair and make-up

Any hair collar length or longer should be tied up.

NO make-up is permitted in school including nail polish and temporary transfers and tattoos.

School Sporting Events

Pupils representing the school at sporting events will be provided with the correct sports kits for participation. These kits should be washed and returned to school within one week of the event. This includes any jacket or school hoodie used. These items are only loaned on a temporary basis and not intended to be kept long term.

Playtimes

Children will go outside at playtime even in the winter and parents are reminded to provide coats hats, scarves and gloves to ensure that their child is warm.

In the winter and the rain wellies are also advised.

Please ensure that ALL children's clothes are clearly named at all times.

The staff will regularly remind children about uniform and if necessary sanction them for incorrect uniform.

Please note - on 'Mufti' non-school uniform days, the children should still be dressed appropriately for school and NO very short shorts, vest or crop tops are allowed under any circumstances. Shoes should also be within the guide lines of the main school uniform to ensure health and safety around the school.
